

## INFORMATION FOR CSULB VISITORS

### NEARBY AIRPORTS *(and distance to CSULB campus):*

- Los Angeles International Airport (LAX ~ 25 mi)
- John Wayne Airport in Santa Ana (SNA ~ 20 mi)
- Long Beach (LGB, ~3.5 mi)

### GROUND TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation to/from the airport can be made by shuttle (see below), rental car (one-way rentals are available), LYFT or UBER. Note that transportation to Long Beach from outlying cities is possible by public bus, but the schedule varies and may not fit the workshop schedule. *(Note: Uber, Lyft, etc. is very easy to access by taking a shuttle bus from the terminal at LAX or directly from the terminal at LGB or SNA.*

*Pricing may vary with time of day (higher in rush hour times), but it is typically competitively priced with shuttles).*

  - Offers shuttle services to and from LAX, including executive sedans, luxury SUVs, and private vans. To arrange a pick-up, you can exit the baggage claim area and go to the white curb. You can also call the dispatch department at (800) 733-8267 or the vehicle status line at (310) 464-0372
- Long Beach Airport Shuttle - LGB - 24-7 Ride - <https://247ride.com/shuttles/long-beach-airport-shuttle>
  - Offers pick-up and drop-off right in front of the terminal at LGB to local hotels.

  - Offers shuttle service to and from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). To arrange a pick-up, you can call Karmel Shuttle at (714) 670-3480 #2 or follow the directions in a welcome text sent to your cell phone upon arrival

### LODGING:

Places to stay in Long Beach are readily available, but some suggestions for ones that are near campus are below. There are also a lot of options near campus on Air BnB and VRBO. \*Note – CSULB graduation is around this time so some hotels may fill early.
