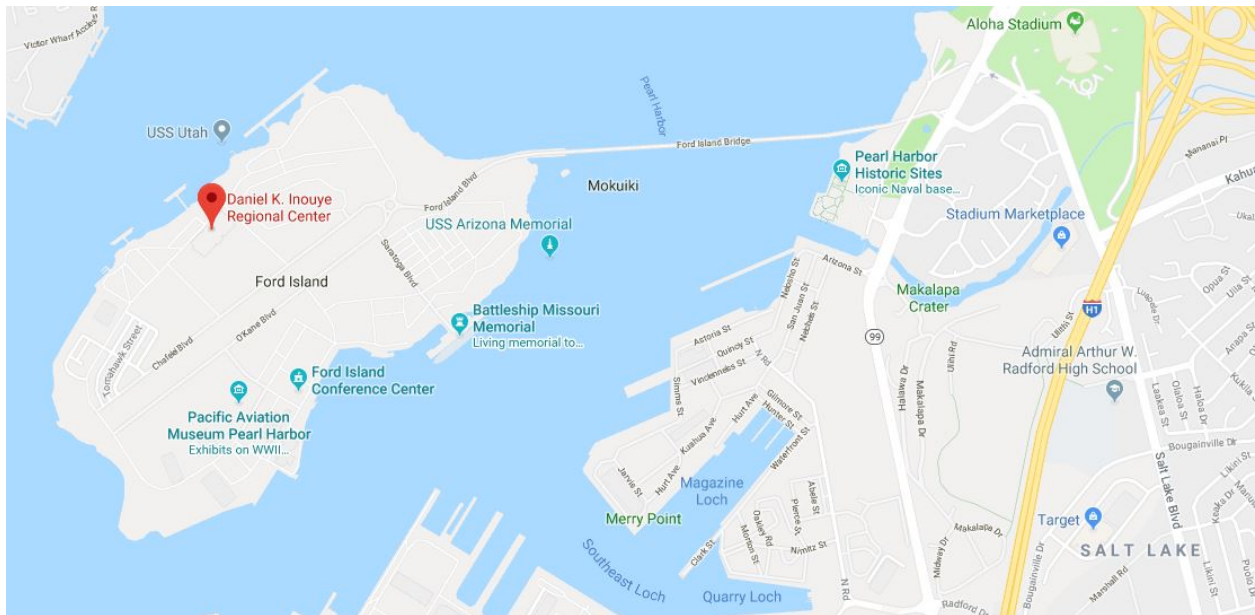

## Access to Ford Island

Joint Base Pearl Harbor Hickam (JBPHH) is responsible for maintaining security and access onto Ford Island. NOAA federal employees and contractors will be granted access to the base by presenting their valid Common Access Card (CAC) at the entrance to Ford Island. The host will organize special event guest access for those without CAC or any other form of base access (e.g. RAPIDGate card). ## Admission to Ford Island

Please have a photo identification and your pass readily available when entering the Ford Island main gate. You may experience some delay at the gate as security guards need to check/scan everybody's ID, so make sure to give yourself some extra time to get to the IRC.

### **Guest Access to the IRC**

IRC guests must be invited by an IRC employee and will be required to sign in at the guard station and obtain a visitor pass.

### **Foreign National Access to the IRC**

We welcome foreign nationals at the IRC. Foreign Nationals, like other guests, must be invited and sponsored by an IRC employee to enter the facility. [Please contact the local co-organizers ASAP and no later than August 15th if you are a foreign national considering attending the workshop.](#) Note that the foreign national access requirements do not apply to US lawful permanent residents.

### **Parking**

All IRC employees and guests are allowed to park in open marked spaces in front of the IRC facility at no charge. Spaces have been reserved for handicapped individuals, long term parking for ship operations, Pacific Tsunami Warning Center shift operations, motorcycles, and government vehicles. Motorcycles and mopeds should park only in designated motorcycle parking spaces. Unless authorized by the IRC Site Manager, employees and guests should not leave their vehicles in the parking lots overnight.

### **Shuttle Service**

Shuttle Service is available to IRC staff and guests. The shuttle runs between the Arizona Memorial and the IRC Facility front entrance on regular business days from 6 – 9 AM and 2:40 – 5:40 PM with on-demand services available from 9 – 2 PM. There are a wide range of accommodation options in Honolulu (especially in Waikiki/Ala Moana area). East-West Center, located on University of Hawai'i at Mānoa campus, also has a limited number of rooms available for people with educational affiliation.
